Camp presents Trailblazer Award to Transamerica

It gives Camp Courageous great honor to recognize Transamerica as a company that has been a true TRAIL BLAZER for almost the entire history of Camp Courageous, going back, nearly 50-years.



Before taking the name Transamerica, the company was first known as Life Investors and then Aegon. Life Investors started supporting Camp Courageous during some of the camp's earliest years, through company and employee support and volunteerism.



Life Investor employees like Theron Thomsen and Art Christoffersen were long time Camp Courageous Board Members. They would carpool in Theron's van to camp's board meetings with fellow board members Dotty Cummins, Kay Pitlik, Bill Quinby, Jim LeMaster, Rich Altorfer, Jim Klinger, and Frieda Thomas. Many adventures took place in that van, as one could imagine with those personalities!

In 1985, to celebrate Life Investors 25th Anniversary, they raffled off a McLaren sports car to benefit Camp Courageous. The raffle was the largest fund raiser to date for the Camp and raised approximately fifty-five thousand dollars. The drawing was held on Valentine's Day, and the winner was a University of Iowa student.

Life Investors introduced thousands of new friends to Camp Courageous. For years, the entire Cedar Rapids

a wide variety of animals and birds to the area.

Daniel and Camp Courageous have been working in conjunction with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR), Greg Schmitt, in particular, to develop this nature area. Camp Courageous is also very fortunate to have the knowledge and talents of Daniel Gibbins, representing Clark McLeod and the Monarch Research Project (MRP). Daniel is also Deputy Director of Linn County Conservation and a professional arborist. Camp Courageous has worked for several years with Daniel, and he has been extremely impressed with the projects that have been done.

MRP is assisting Camp in a planned forestation of the Camp's property, not just a plan, they have agreed to assist Camp with the regular planting of some exceptional trees for the near future! Camp Courageous, which was built on a pine tree plantation, loves trees, and this will go a long way toward the strategic planting of trees to help with beautification, wind breaks, shade, erosion control, creating a sound buffer, and so much more.

Camp is very excited about this continued relationship going forward!

Audrey Egger, whose roots were in Monticello, IA, married Richard Pierce and they settled in Florida. Audrey's last desire was to have her ashes returned home to Monticello and be buried next to her parents, Harold & Ann Egger. Harold & Ann were longtime friends, and supporters of Camp Courageous. Thanks to those pictured here, who went above and beyond, Audrey's wishes were fulfilled. I have sometimes been criticized for not throwing away anything. I decided to take a long shot and went to the basement of our offices and looked through some of my old 'People' files. And there was a file I established over two decades ago entitled Dick & Audrey Pierce. In the file was the Pierces and the Eggers history of giving to Camp Courageous. Then attached to the file was a note I had made for myself.

A phone call from Audrey Pierce on 7/29/2002 at 9 AM stating she was Audrey Pierce from Florida, and "in her will everything goes to Camp Courageous." She mentioned her dad, Harold, died in 1986 followed by her mom Ann in 1997. (Her folks lived a short distance from me, and we had been friends.) She talked about being from Monticello in 1960s and went to Florida in 1970s. My note continues.... "No Kids - All goes to Camp".

Unfortunately, Audrey and Richard, met up with a personal financial planner in Florida. That person worked their way into their personal lives and became Power of Attorney, and etc. As a result, they went from being very successful, to dying with nothing. As a matter of fact, Richard died when the house he was living in, burned down, with him in it.

Over my 46 years at Camp Courageous I have run across too many cases where people have taken advantage of the elderly and the vulnerable. Unlike many, Camp Courageous and Charlie Becker, will not turn our backs when wrong has been done. It is not about the money;

it is about stopping bad people from taking advantage of good people. In this case, there was only Dick & Audrey, two very good and caring and wonderful people, who unfortunately were also very vulnerable. Audrey had high hopes for supporting Camp Courageous in the end, but at least these folks (pictured), and Camp Courageous helped achieve her last desire - to be returned to Monticello to be with her parents.

Camp had an attorney representing it in this case, and now Camp is recommending the case be turned over to the Florida Attorney General's Office, for further actions...

A Note About Camp's Continuity Challenges from CEO Charlie Becker



Camp Courageous has had the good fortune to go through decades of continuity in staff. One of the many secrets to its success is the desire to hire exceptional staff, treat them exceptionally well, and hope they make Camp Courageous their lifelong career.

Nursing Director Sharon Roller, Program Director Jeanne Muellerleile, and myself, are all the same age (within three months of each other). All three of us turned 65 at the end of 2019. Three of the top positions having the potential to leave an organization at the same time could throw any organization into a tailspin by itself; then the Covid pandemic quickly followed, beginning around March 2020.

Many long-time Camp members retired within a few years of each

other. Jeanne Muellerleile retired after nearly forty years; Sharon Roller retired after nearly thirty years; Pam Mayo, Camp's CFO, retired after over thirty years; Becky Melchert, Camp's Administrative Assistant, retired after twenty-five years; Matt Bollwitt was with Camp for 25-years as IT Director; Dennis Bayne was with camp for decades, first as Dietary Director and then as a volunteer for dietary, even well past his 65th birthday; and the list goes on.

Camp Courageous' staff continuity was exceptional for decades. All these past staff, along with many others with years and years of service, continue to provide the Camp endless guidance and support to this day, which has been a heartwarming testament to employee sentiment.

Since Covid, Camp Courageous

has gone through a lot of turnover in staff; and then factor in a huge drought in the labor force due to Covid, and it makes for challenging times. This is something Camp has not experienced before, but every day gets better -- we are seeing some exceptional hires and exceptional volunteers stepping forward.

Even though Camp Courageous continues to look for a new CEO, this new CEO must continue to be extremely involved until staffing is stabilized once again. In the meantime, if you know that perfect candidate for the CEO position here at Camp, please let me know.

I plan to provide as much personal guidance to the new person as they want; throughout the transition process and for the rest of my life. I will always be only a phone call away for advice and support, just as all those named here and many others continue to do.

Camp Courageous is a beautiful, heartwarming organization that will only grow and touch more wonderful lives of those with disabilities in the future.

Mary Lou Erlacher spent the week volunteering at Camp Courageous while her granddaughter, Katie, enjoys another memorable session at camp. Katie has been attending Camp Courageous for many years, beginning with school-sponsored visits and continuing into adulthood through the Linn-Mar Success Center.

With a background in education for the hearing impaired, Mary Lou has long been an advocate for children with unique learning needs. In 1984, recognizing a lack of local educational options for students like her son, she partnered with a colleague who specialized in Language Arts to establish a pilot school in Cedar Rapids named Linn Academy. Despite limited support from public schools, they launched the program with 28 students and 4 dedicated teachers in a building owned by the Marion School District, which also housed a Grant Wood program and preschool.

Mary Lou's story is a testament to the power of perseverance, community support, and the difference one person can make. We're grateful for her continued dedication and support of Camp Courageous.



He drove out and sure enough water was pouring out of the front door of one of the camper cabins...and who did we call, but Randy Brokaw. New walk-in coolers, freezers, ice machine, and so much more were all installed and serviced by Randy.

Then there was Peace Church Member, Agnes Duit. Agnes Duit was the Camp Office Manager through the three Executive Directors of Camp Courageous - Gary Turbes, 4 years; Bud Ewell, 2 years; and then me, Charlie Becker. During times of many challenges in Camp Courageous history; when the Camp was fighting to survive; Agnes was the glue that held everything together.

And lastly, when Peace Church's Pastor, Terry Rehling, took over the

reins as board President of Camp Courageous 12 years into the Camp's history, it was a complete game changer. Before Terry, board meetings were interesting... I would need to drink a half a bottle of Pepto-Bismol before each meeting. During a time when over half the board was prepared to resign, Terry stepped forward to lead the Camp as President of its Board of Directors from 1982 to 1984.

Under Terry's leadership the Camp began to reshape its priorities and build what today touches the lives of thousands. Camp Courageous and Camp and I will be forever grateful to Terry Rehling for stepping forward and leading the Camp during its most challenging time.

When Peace Church held their 150th anniversary celebration, Camp welcomed Terry back with open arms, after having been away for over 30-years.

Joyce Murphy passed away, but those of us who traveled with her know she is not gone. She left something in us, in the shared jokes, the stories, and the way


we'll catch ourselves smiling at a roadside stop because it reminds us of her. She showed us that the real souvenirs are the people you meet and the memories you didn't plan on making.
